The autumn period has been very fruitful for the project: activities this quarter, in line with the overall objective of the twinning programme, were aimed at enhancing the level of safety through the following missions concerning: certification of aerodromes and new air navigation services, SMS Implementation for PART 145/M/ G, Part-66 National license system implementation, Part-66/147 Training Need Analysis (TNA) System Implementation, Co-ordinated approvals (MEL, RVSM, LVO, ETOPS), UAV airworthiness. Two important missions concerning capacity building of auditors in the field of aeromedicine, as well as on the job training for ramp inspectors, took place in October 2016. 5 Ramp inspectors paid a visit to their counterparts in Paris, Marseilles and Lyon airports, following a successful French mission in Istanbul and Antalya last May.
