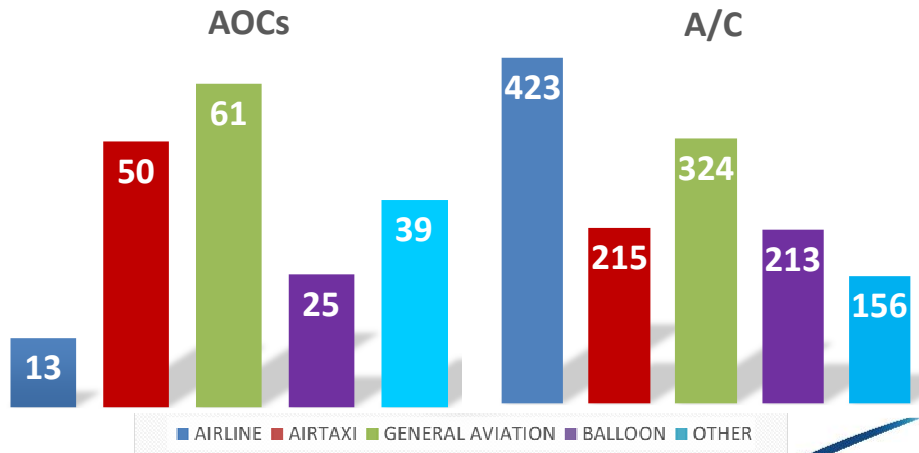

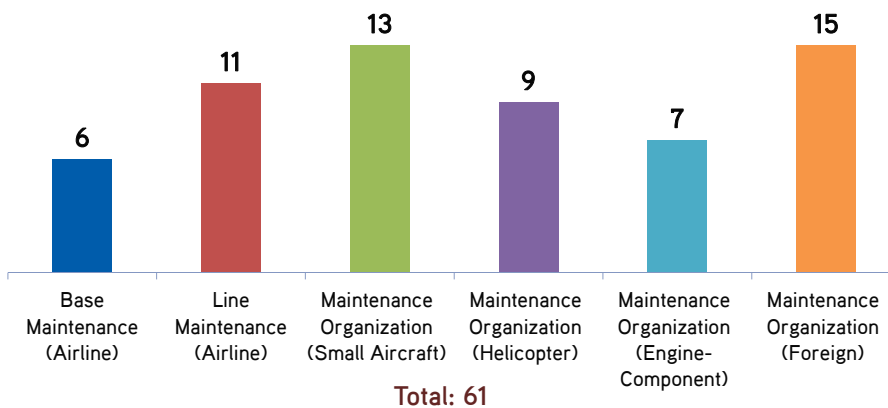

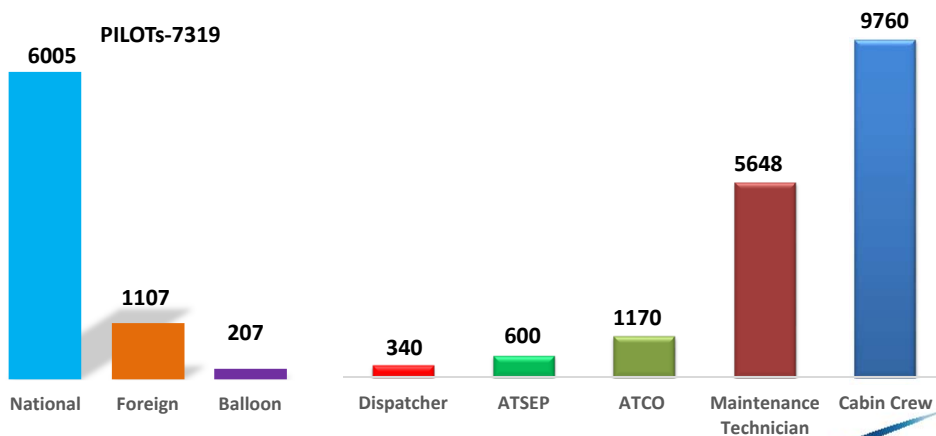

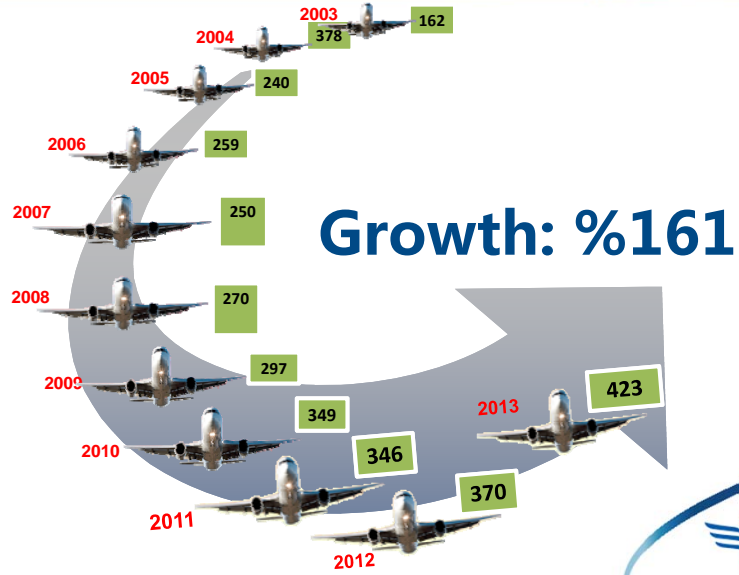

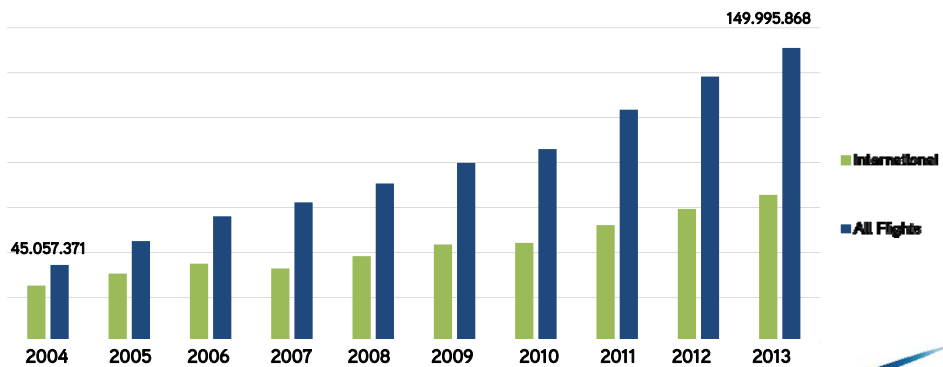


AIRCRAFT FLEET IN AIRLINES



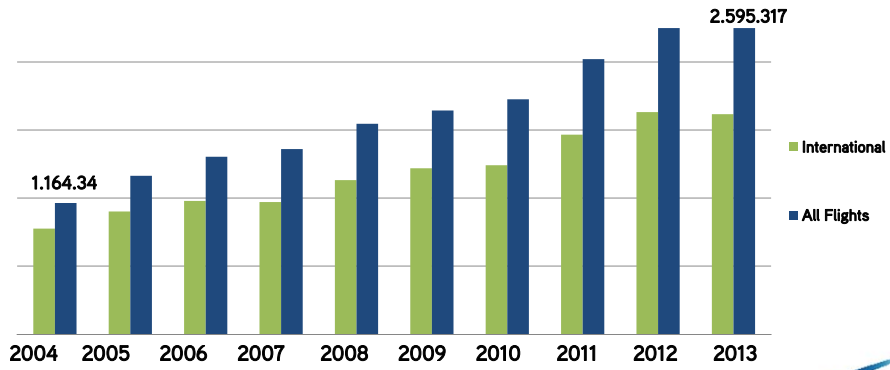
PASSENGERS CARRIED

Increase %233



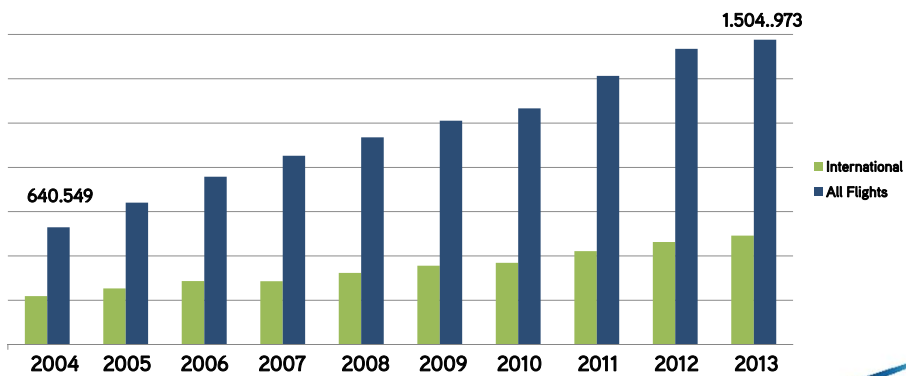
CARGO CARRIED (Tones)

Increase %123



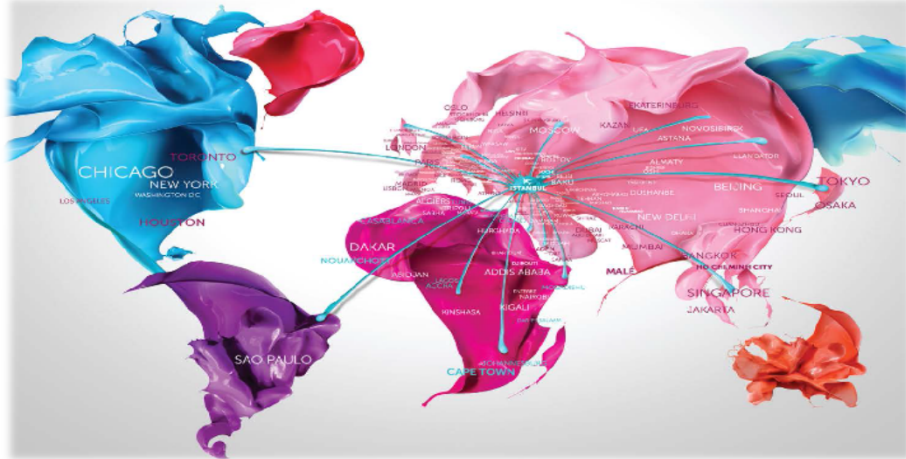
FLIGHT TRAFFIC

ICAO COUNCIL ELECTIONS 2013 and 2016: EUROPEAN STRATEGY
(Presented by the President of ECAC)

- (i) The Black Sea-Caspian Rotation Group will postpone its presentation of a candidate to the ICAO Council until the election of 2016.
- (ii) The ECAC Member States commit themselves to support a candidate from the Black Sea-Caspian Rotation Group, as one of the European candidates submitted for election to the Council in that year, and to seek support for that candidate from the other Regional Organisations.
