Summer 2016 has been an interesting period for Civil Aviation twinning as 6 activities were performed by French and Turkish experts. Air navigation deliverables took the lead with experts groups working on Road Map on the certification systems for the new air navigation service, Safety Oversight of changes, as well as ATCO licensing English proficiency and medical fitness.

Rule Making and Training Department experts took part in a workshop covering Development of job descriptions for SHGM staff. This quarter, 2 Turkish missions were sent to France. SAFA Handbook review was conducted in Paris and Toulouse, following French visit in Ankara last April. Turkish delegation has been able to test

the Paris - Toulouse high speed train and discover the hometown of Airbus Group.

Air crew team from SHGM made a remarkable visit to DGAC headquarters in Paris from June 20 to 23 during which technical requirements and administrative procedures in line with EU 1178/2011 were addressed. Turkish colleagues also discovered the French capital driving around Paris using Autolib self-service electric cars, a change from usual public transport systems!

Project Steering committee organized on September 8th in Ankara welcomed C. Virlan for



the first time as junior project leader from CAA Romania, and positively assessed project results.
